here are a couple of observations:

1. Given the location, need someone to address private insurance. Some of the homes in this area had private insurance.
2. FEMA - need someone there that can address home insurance coverage, personal coverage is what most will be interested in applying for. They would love someone that could tell them exactly what is likely to be covered, and what is not! That is not likely possible at a general meeting. They don't want a DC administrator who isn't knowledgeable in addressing housing losses.
3. This folks have been devastated. They are looking for solutions and compassion!
