I work in the SC Lt. Governor's Office on Aging where I oversee all of our informational services, including I&R/A to Aging Network Policies.

Last week, while at a conference, I went to share the Aging in America brochure and noted there was a difference in the statistics from the printed brochures that NASUAD sent to our office.

Our printed brochures show a population increase of 60% with a funding decrease of 59%. The online brochure reflects a 60% increase and a 32% decrease.

Could you or someone in the office help to confirm the accurate data?
