Gov. Nikki Haley establishes Regulatory Review Task Force

COLUMBIA, S.C. – Governor Nikki Haley today signed an executive order establishing the Governor's Regulatory Review Task Force, an eleven member group that will include the chairman of the Small Business Regulatory Review Committee, to review and reduce government involvement in business and create a more simplified and market-friendly regulatory system.

The executive order, signed during today's Cabinet meeting, requires all cabinet agencies and encourages all non-cabinet agencies to comprehensively review all current and proposed statutes, rules, regulations, and processes in order to assess their impact on South Carolina's economy and to determine whether their costs to businesses and employers outweigh their intended benefits. Agency reviews will be evaluated by a task force with appointees from the majority party and minority party leaders of the South Carolina Senate and House of Representatives, representatives from different business sectors and the conservation community.

According to the governor's order, the task force will develop a report by November 15, 2013, that evaluates South Carolina's current regulatory burdens on all sizes and types of businesses in South Carolina and proposes recommendations to relieve those burdens.
