WHEREAS, teaching children the importance of good deeds makes them more caring, loving, and kind; and

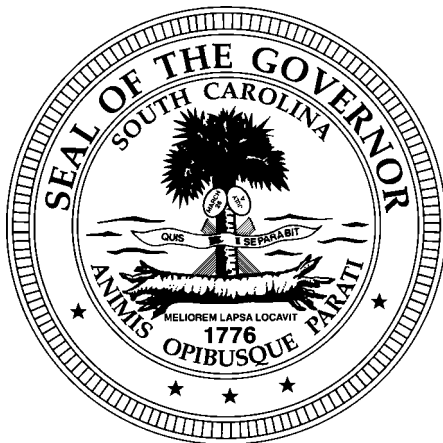
