Jimmy,

Per my conversation with you earlier today, I wanted to recap the conversation I had with Cindy Scopy (sp) from the State Newspaper this afternoon.

Cindy stated that she planned to write a column on what / who SCI is. She also planned to do an editorial on the Ethic's Commission the same day; however she did not indicate when it would "hit the press." During the conversation, I mentioned our project with DMV. She had a couple of questions regarding this that I wanted to share with you and Marcia.

- While discussing the portal the following is how / why we discussed DMV briefly:
  - When was the Master Agreement signed – I told her last summer, that we had to do a business plan and a portal improvement plan as our first deliverables
  - I told her that we then signed a SLA with DMV on March 30<sup>th</sup> to deliver Driver's History Records – she asked if that was live and I said yes
  - She asked if our DMV application was tied to a previous DMV project to make more information available to insurers – I told her that I did not think so, but that she should discuss that with DMV, specifically mentioning Marcia
  - She noted that DMV had several online applications and wanted to know if we were going to be involved with those – I told her that I thought DMV had done a great job making its services available online and that I did not anticipate being involved with those, but rather working with other agencies that needed additional services online or that needed to have an online presence
- We then sent back to discussing the portal

I wanted to make you aware of this in case she calls following up on any of the above.
