Ag and Natural Resources Unite to Solve Issues

The Governor's Summit on Agriculture and Natural Resources convened early on March 13 at the State Museum in Columbia. The Summit was developed to provide a forum for representatives from agricultural organizations, public officials and farmers to develop solutions to some critical issues facing South Carolina's second largest industry—food, fiber, and forestry.

The meeting, which was facilitated by Freddy Vang of the S.C. Department of Natural Resources, opened with introductions to the issues by Commissioner Les Tindal—State Supported Ag Infrastructure; Dr. John Kelly, Vice President of Clemson University's Public Service and Agriculture - Research, Education and Marketing Programs; David Winkles of the SC Farm Bureau - Sustainable Economic Development; Freddy Vang of the SC Department of Natural Resources-Water Use and Environmental Issues; and Bernie Wright, State Director of the SC-USDA-Rural Development Service-Urban Encroachment and Land Use Planning.

Governor Jim Hodges then charged the group to reach a consensus on the issues presented. He said that the solutions developed at the Summit would be presented to him in a written report. Participants were then divided into groups to work on possible solutions to the issues and established the following as some of their top priorities:

- increase public awareness/education of S.C. agriculture
- secure state funds to match federal and farmer funds for irrigation and other programs
- encourage agribusiness expansion and development and create an understanding that agribusiness is just as important to South Carolina's economy as any other business
- support agricultural dependent rural areas

"Profitability" rose to the top as the underlying focus, and the results of the sessions became the objectives in how to make agriculture and natural resources more profitable. Many who attended the Governor's Ag Summit left with the hope that the solutions to the issues will, indeed, become realities in the near future.

The Taste of South Carolina Quality

South Carolina products grace our tables on a daily basis (I hope). But when you're in a restaurant, how often do you stop to wonder whether the chef is using locally grown products?

If the chef is concerned with quality and freshness, then he or she is using S.C. products when they're in season. And, hoping to see how creative local chefs could be with our products, the S.C. Department of Agriculture began presenting the Serving South Carolina Quality Award in 1994 at the annual Taste of the Tidelands Gala in Litchfield. The award goes to the chef who uses specified S.C. products in the best-tasting, enticing and most unique dish. As the years have passed, the award has become more and more prestigious, and each year more than a dozen chefs compete for it.

This year, David Bardari, chef and owner of The Community House Restaurant on Pawleys Island, won the Serving South Carolina Quality Award for the third time in his career. Each chef was to choose at least one of seven S.C. products to include in their meal, but David used them all. His main dish was an herb-roasted breast of turkey and a sausage Shiitake stuf fed turkey leg, served with no-lumps giblet gravy, sweet potato soufflé topped with toasted peanut sauce, sautéed spinach and stewed cabbage. It was a wonderful, nutritious meal full of S.C. products.

David's talents derived from a long line of cooks. His grandparents, both of whom were born in Italy, took their cooking very seriously—seriously enough to have a "prep" kitchen separate from their main kitchen.

Judging from all his awards, I would say David has been a very successful chef. After graduating from the Culinary Institute of America, David was a pastry chef, among many other things, at a Connecticut restaurant where he trained with the former chef of The 21 Club and La Felida. Later, he helped design and open a new Northern Italian restaurant called Bacci's in Southbury Conn., where he was the general manager. In 1992 he was approached by investors who wanted to buy a restaurant in Pawleys Island. So he packed everything and moved to South Carolina to open The Community House. After a two-year break from The Community House, he returned to become the sole owner.

As head chef and owner, David renovated the restaurant, giving it a Mediterranean theme. And you can bet that whenever they're in season, David is serving fresh South Carolina products. David is very particular about his ingredients—especially produce. He told me that he always looks for locally grown fruits and vegetables. Obviously, he wants only the best for his customers.

The annual Taste of the Tidelands Gala encourages culinary creativity, promotes local restaurants and tourism, raises money for local charities and provides scholarships for culinary students. The event also brings South Carolina products into the limelight, giving credit to those who work so hard to produce our food. I think all our chefs should make every effort to buy S.C. products for their restaurants—then they could certainly guarantee freshness!

Easter Story Cookies (submitted by Jann Perry)

You need: 1 c. whole pecans, 1 tsp. vinegar, 3 egg whites, 1 pinch salt, 1 c. sugar, Zipper baggie, wooden spoon, tape and Bible

Preheat oven to 300 degrees F. Place pecans in zipper baggie and let children beat them with the wooden spoon to break into small pieces.

Explain that after Jesus was arrested he was beaten by the Roman soldiers. Read John 19:1-3.

Let each child smell the vinegar. Put 1-tsp. vinegar into mixing bowl.

Explain that when Jesus was thirsty on the cross he was given vinegar to drink. Read John 19:28-30.

Add egg whites to vinegar. Eggs represent life. Explain that Jesus gave His life to give us life. Read John 10:10-11.

Sprinkle a little salt into each child's hand. Let them taste it and brush the rest into the bowl. Explain that this represents the salty tears shed by Jesus' followers, and the bitterness of our own sin. Read Luke 23:27.

So far the ingredients are not very appetizing. Add 1-c. sugar. Explain that the sweetest part of the story is that Jesus died because He loves us. He wants us to know and belong to Him. Read Psalms 34:8 and John 3:16.

Beat with a mixer on high speed for 12 to 15 minutes until stiff peaks are formed. Explain that the color white represents the purity in God's eyes of those whose sins have been cleansed by Jesus. Read Isaiah 1:18 and John 3:1-3.

Fold in broken nuts. Drop by teaspoons onto wax paper covered cookie sheet. Explain that each mound represents the rocky tomb where Jesus' body was laid. Read Matt. 27:57-60.

Put the cookie sheet in the oven; close the door and turn the oven OFF.

Give each child a piece of tape and seal the oven door. Explain that Jesus' tomb was sealed. Read Matt. 27:65-66.

GO TO BED! Explain that they may feel sad to leave the cookies in the oven overnight. Jesus' followers were in despair when the tomb was sealed. Read John 16:20 & 22.

On Easter morning, open the oven and give everyone a cookie. Notice the cracked surface and take a bite. The cookies are hollow! On the first Easter, Jesus' followers were amazed to find the tomb open and empty. Read Matt. 28:1-9. HE HAS RISEN!
