Subject: Anderson Shooting Case Update

Rob,

Per your request, I have asked DJJ and DSS to get you easily digestible one-pagers by 9:30am tomorrow.

But in the interim, below is the most recent information I have received from each agency regarding their respective involvement:

1. DSS

- a. DSS received an anonymous tip for potential abuse by the father (spanking with a belt) in January of this year.
- b. DSS referred it to community-based prevention services (CBPS) in the local area who subsequently follow up with the family.
- c. The family turned down services and the report back to DSS did not show evidence of abuse and neglect so DSS did not open a case.
- d. Director Alford is having her team do a complete review of the incident to see if there was anything they should have picked up on or some other break down on their end.

2. DJJ

- a. In March, the juvenile came in contact with law enforcement for bringing a machete to school.
- b. Following that incident, the juvenile was assigned to a DJJ psychologist for evaluation which showed some mental concerns.
- c. Subsequently, the case went to court in August at which time the judge sentenced the juvenile to one year probation (the judge uses the mental evaluation in determining sentencing).
- d. After sentencing is when DJJ had formal responsibility for probation monitoring, and subsequently had their first probation check with the juvenile less than a month later on September 2 (normal checks are once a month).
- e. DJJ Community Services Deputy is traveling to Oconee tomorrow for a full run-down of the case.

If anything new comes through before you receive anything from the agencies tomorrow morning, I will be sure to follow up to this email.
