AVNETNEWS Copyright- As of Oct 2, 2017 SCOTUS DENIED Petitioner for Certiorari in the Michigan Doe. v. Snyder case where the 6th ckt determined the Michigan sex offender laws were unconstitutional retroactive punishment termed as EX-POST FACTO, not regulatory but more heavy handed than probation and without due process. In a conversation with the clerk, it was explained the plaintiffs have twenty five days to file a Motion for Rehearing before the Order becomes final.

Related cases are not limited to the Colorado case decided last fall where the Colorado sex offender registration law is "cruel and unusual" – unconstitutional. These cases are a wake up call to heavy handed political agendas based on the myth of "frighteningly high" recidivism rates for sex offenders such as Florida. DOJ research and 7 other independent research projects from states including Washington State, Arizona, Ohio, Minnesota, Michigan, and others demonstrate sex offenders are the lowest of recidivism rates among any group of offenders. The deprecation of life, liberty, property and family through defamatory publication of a person is call STIGMA-PLUS, see Paul v. Davis, Scotus and Rehberg v. Paulk, 11k Ckt. Both Michigan and Colorado demonstrate sex offender laws affect life, liberty, property and family; whereas, the 6th ckt called sex offender registration a similar scarlett letter to a "moral leper."

Recently California ended lifetime sex-offender registry, although information is a bit sketchy. They have also implemented a 3 tier system to distinguish risk levels; however,

some say it lacks credibility since it is not based on scientific risk assessment, but rather, the past offense raising separation of powers concerns. Other states are following suit such as Pennsylvania and possibly Florida.
