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Subject: Cleaning equipment/supplies for DMV locales

I have some info from a company that contacted us to look at supplying what he says will be all of the "state of the art" cleaning equipment, supplies, and chemicals for us to handle all of the DMV's. The word is that he'd provide somewhere in the neighborhood of 10 trailers full of everything from buffers to mops (\$60,000 per trailer initial cost I think) plus keep them stocked for the year (\$25,000 per year in chemicals, etc) for free.
