I.) Program Design

Program design call - Highlights:

- 1.) NFP realizing they will be required to do much more recruitment than ever before ("Interesting & Proactive Recruitment Strategy")
- 2.) Social Finance will submit proposal for engaging investors to gauge risk tolerance
- 3.) They feel our designation of young AND low income is arbitrary – pushing for one or the other

NFP proposal: Targeting high-risk areas, but don't turn away mothers because they don't meet eligibility criteria:

- Operationally, it may be difficult to verify income - can income be driven by targeting high-need areas?
- They are concerned that if they have hard income and age restrictions, they can't build an effective referral network (targeting, trust, etc.)
- One option is to set parameters (similar to % of moms served from new counties) on the % of moms served who are young and low income. That way, they don't need to turn people away but will prioritize young, low income mothers
- Data Need: Excel List and Map of all first-time, Medicaid mothers by age, location (at the most localized level) and income (do we have anything more specific than Medicaid eligible?)
  - This will be a recurring data need (updated version sent at least every few months to enable NFP to target high-risk areas – real time data)
  - Are we sure this is all we want?
  - Can Tony request this ASAP from Ana? Erica still waiting on baseline data
  - Can Tony access BOI dataset?

Identification of young pregnancies from DHHS' side

- Curam Risk Assessment Tool – do we still move forward with this if we only screen on age and income?
- We can identify teenagers in Truven approx. 90 days after first prenatal visit
- MCOs may be able to identify and refer them sooner, but this is hit-or-miss (MCO team)

- Identifying young mothers early on will mostly be responsibility of NFP
