**1. RESOLUTION**

**A RESOLUTION HONORING MR. EDDIE ELLIS**

**Councilwoman Cooper-Smith asked that Chairman Wright and Councilman Owens join her on the floor as she began to present the resolution to Mr. Ellis. She asked all of Mr. Ellis supporters to stand. Councilwoman Cooper-Smith proceeded to read the contents of the resolution. Mr. Ellis thanked everyone who has been a part of his continued success.**

**4. ORDINANCE-THIRD AND FINAL READING**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF ORANGEBURG COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA, AMENDING THE ZONING MAP OF UNINCORPORATED ORANGEBURG COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA, TO CHANGE THE ZONING DESIGNATION FOR THE REAL PROPERTY DESCRIBED AS TMS #0206-00-01-033.000 FROM FA (FOREST AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT) TO CG (COMMERCIAL GENERAL DISTRICT); AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**Chairman Wright asked that County Administrator Harold Young give a brief summary for the public. Mr. Young stated that the Planning Commission met on June 12, 2013 to consider this rezoning request. The parcel is located on Five Chop Road Tax Map #0206-00-01-033.000. The request is a change from FA to CG. The Shrine Club wishes to build a new meeting hall at this location, which is located on 301, next to the Ameri-Gas Propane Company. Mr. Young stated that the Planning Commission on its June 12, 2013 meeting recommended approval of this request. He also stated that they have had two past readings and a public hearing and this is the recommendation for approval for third and final reading.**

**A motion was entered by Councilman Clyde Livingston and seconded by Councilwoman Cooper-Smith that the ordinance be adopted. Motion carried.**

## **5. ACCEPTANCE OF BIDS**

### **1. PURCHASE/COLLECTION OF SCRAP METAL AND WHITE GOODS**

**County Administrator Harold Young stated that this was a request for Proposal (FY14-0821) for the purchase and collection of scrap metal and white goods at all Orangeburg County convenient sites. The bid was advertised in the Times and Democrat and SCBO newspapers. A mandatory pre-bid was held on August 14, 2013. Only two (2) vendors were represented, Sunshine Recycling and Don Auto Crushing, both from Orangeburg County. Mr. Young stated that after reviewing the information that was received, the winning firm is Sunshine Recycling where the price per ton for scrap metal is \$246.40. The price per ton for white goods is \$246.40. Mr. Young recommended this to council for their approval.**

**Chairman Wright asked if there were any questions. Councilwoman Cooper-Smith asked where the scrap goods would be transported to after it leaves the landfill. Councilman Owens asked what materials would be considered white goods and Councilwoman Cooper-Smith stated that refrigerators and any other major household appliances are considered white goods.**

**Chairman Wright asked for a motion to accept the bid. A motion was made by Councilman Heyward Livingston and seconded by Councilman Clyde B. Livingston. Motion carried.**


