In follow-up to our conversation about the history of the gasoline tax, attached are some pages from previous budgets.

FY 96-97 was the last year the "county" portion of the gasoline tax was in the General Fund (and part of the BEA estimate). In FY 97-98, in Part II Section 50 and 51, the distribution of the gas tax to the counties was amended and taken out of the General Fund.
