SUMMARY REPORT

Meeting of Commission on Higher Education, January 9, 1986

ELECTION OF OFFICERS

Mr. Fred R. Sheheen, Camden, and Mr. Robert C. Gallager, Charleston, were reelected Chairman and Vice Chairman of the Commission, respectively, for 1986.

APPROVAL OF REVISED STANDARDS FOR TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAMS

The Education Improvement Act of 1984 requires the State Board of Education to develop, in consultation with the Commission on Higher Education, and promulgate additional and revised standards for teacher education programs. On November 8, 1985, the State Board of Education announced its intent to promulgate proposed new standards and procedures at its meeting in January 1986. The Commission approved the proposed standards.

CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

The Commission approved a request by the University of South Carolina for authorization to use \$210,000 in institutional funds for the architectural and engineering planning phase of a new building for its School of Music.

RESIGNATION OF COMMISSION MEMBER

Mr. W. Jerry Fedder, Seneca, has resigned from the Commission, effective immediately, to assume a position on the South Carolina Industrial Commission.

RETIREMENT OF EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Dr. Howard R. Boozer, Executive Director of the Commission, announced his retirement effective June 30, 1986. Dr. Boozer has served as Executive Director since July 1, 1973.
