Morrison, former partner of Nelson Mullins Law Firm and past board chair of Columbia Urban League, who used his legal skills to advance social justice and equal opportunity for the disadvantage and underserved. This award is being presented to Governor Haley for her courageous leadership and swift action in mobilizing the South Carolina General Assembly to remove the divisive Confederate Flag from the State House grounds in response to the massacre of the Mother Emmanuel Nine in Charleston, South Carolina.
