Dear Tony:

This is a follow up to a recent e-mail we sent asking your help with a project to create guidelines for states wishing to develop, or revise existing, uniform statewide reporting systems for Title IIIB legal services (Guidelines). In that email we said we would be sending a survey to your state's legal services developer, or other appropriate staff member, asking for information about your state's current Title IIIB legal services reporting practices. We have just completed emailing that survey.
