

SC Teachers’ Tour – Teaching about Sustainable Forestry

The SC Forestry Commission is now accepting applications for their SC Teachers’ Tour to be held June 19th through 22nd , 2001 in the Upstate region. Teacher participants will spend four days touring the forests of South Carolina and examining forestry practices and the forest industry. Topics covered will be: forest management; emphasizing sustainable forestry, ecosystem management and bio-diversity; forest product production, including harvesting and processing into products; and wildlife conservation including endangered species protection.

Participants will also receive resource materials to use in the classrooms along with training in Project Learning Tree, an activity-based multi-disciplinary environmental education curriculum designed to teach critical and creative thinking. Preference will be given to full-time certified school teachers for grades 3 – 8, specializing in environmental studies and Secondary teachers specializing in environmental studies, life sciences, biology, Tech Prep or natural resource education.

All meals, lodging, materials, and transportation during the tour will be provided FREE by the sponsors of the Teachers’ Tour. Teachers wishing to earn graduate credit offered by the University of Charleston will be required to pay a small fee (\$20 per credit hour) upon acceptance into the tour. (Additional attendance and work is required for graduate credit.)

2001 Dairy Conference

The 2001 Clemson Annual Dairy Conference, SC Dairy Association Annual Meeting, and the SC Dairy Association Board Meeting are scheduled to be held on Thursday, March 1, 2001, at the Clemson Outdoor Laboratory in Kresge Hall near T. Ed Garrison Livestock Arena in Clemson.

The program will focus on an update of the future of the milk processing industry and on dairy herd nutrition. Dr. Charles While from the Department of Food Science and Technology at Mississippi State University and Dr. William Chalupa, a well-known ruminant nutritionist from the School of Veterinary Medicine at the University of Pennsylvania, will make presentations.

Registration fee is \$15 per person and includes breaks and lunch. Deadline for pre-registration is Friday, February 23, 2001.

Conservation Reserve Program Update

As of December 31, 2000, South Carolina had 218,109 acres enrolled in the Conservation Reserve Program (CRP). Although no general CRP signup is scheduled for fiscal year 2001, producers with contracts expiring September 30, 2001, have been afforded an opportunity to extend their CRP contracts for one year. Producers with CRP contracts expiring on September 30, 2001, must request to extend their contracts for one year by May 31, 2001. In South Carolina approximately 4,000 acres under contract will expire on September 30, 2001.

County FSA Offices continue to accept offers under the 23rd Continuous CRP signup. Some of the most popular practices available under the Continuous signup are the establishment of shallow water areas for wildlife on cropland acres and of riparian buffers on cropland acres and marginal pastureland acres.

The 23rd Continuous CRP signup began October 1, 2000, and will end on September 30, 2001. As of December 31, 2000, South Carolina had 268.5 acres enrolled under the 23rd Continuous CRP signup.

The youth in agriculture meeting included speaker like Maria Napier, from the SC Farm Bureau, who spoke on her program, "Ag in the Classroom".

Educating and informing the people who promote agriculture is a fundamental priority for the Council. Through the instruction of representatives of agriculture, the Ag Council helps create a better informed public as well.

Since agriculture is a significant portion of our state’s economy, our citizens, both farmer and consumer, should be concerned about the promotion of agriculture in our state. The SCAC, which is both educational and promotional in nature, endeavors to accomplish this task.

I commend the members of the SC Agricultural Council for their efforts during the past forty plus years. On behalf of the members of the agricultural community, thank you for continuing to create a forum to solve problems and to present a positive view of agriculture in South Carolina.
