A small, brick building with a pent roof (0159.7) appears to date to the early to mid-nineteenth century. The structure is of unknown use, but it has a central door on the eastern elevation and a single window opening on the south elevation. The structure is of American common bond masonry, with seven rows of stretchers between rows of headers; two rowlock courses create a header over the doorway. Based on the varying shapes, textures, and colors of the brick, the bricks appear to be handmade.
