
Chairman Mike Holden called the meeting to order and Mr. Tom Martin gave the invocation. Everyone stood and pledged allegiance to the flag.

Chairman Holden explained that the meeting was called for the purpose of reviewing and screening applications for the position of County Administrator; however it was brought to Anderson County Council's attention of a semi-emergency matter that needed to be discussed. He asked Mr. Tom Martin to read a resolution which was prepared.
