South Carolina's ethics law has "many good features in it" but it "left out the two things that were most needed," former state attorney general Travis Medlock told the Kiwanis Club of Orangeburg on Monday. One of the things that's needed is more disclosure about how candidates spend their campaign funds, he said. "Buying Granny a new dress for the inauguration is not" an allowable use of campaign funds.

Note: Medlock, a former state senator, was co-chair of Gov. Nikki Haley's 11-member, bipartisan South Carolina Commission on Ethics Reform. "We were asked to review all of the state laws relating to ethics laws and violations and find out what's wrong with them," he said. The most comprehensive ethics bill was passed in 1991 after an FBI sting dubbed "Operation Lost Trust" resulted in the convictions of more than a dozen lawmakers and "the Legislature reacted — had to react."

South Carolina State University trustees will meet with Gov. Nikki Haley Friday afternoon in Columbia to look at ways she can help the university, Haley spokesman Rob Godfrey said Tuesday. The governor believes higher education is more important to the state than ever and S.C. State is a very vital part of her economic development efforts regionally and statewide, he said.

Note: Haley's concern and advice, however, will be valuable to the board, he said. "I feel that she is generally concerned about where we are and what we're doing — about the general reputation and news stories," Waldrep said.
