I wish to be ensured that the recommendations stated in the current Kinley Creek Watershed Study of August 2015, be taken seriously and persons in authority select and implement the "best" recommendation(s). Apparently two prior studies of the Kinley Creek Watershed have been conducted, but as acknowledged by Lexington County Council at its meeting of January 12, 2016, no recommendations have ever been implemented.

Please give your most urgent attention to this very serious matter. The recent flooding with the Kinley Creek Watershed, located in District #2 has resulted in catastrophic structural damages to our homes. As well as immeasurable emotional turmoil. PLEASE help us in ensuring actions will be taken to rectify the flooding issues. Two of the top three recommendations from the study involves buying out and demolishing homes along the creek. If so, we wish to consider our property market value prior to the 10/04/2015 flood.

At that time, I CANNOT afford to repair my home.

Please keep me informed of your opinion and intention on this very serious and important matter.
