Commissioner's Column

Cotton Museum celebrates grand opening

Cotton may not be considered king anymore, but that doesn't lessen its importance to S.C. agriculture. In fact, one of the state's agriculture museums is devoted solely to cotton and celebrates a grand opening Friday, Oct. 8.

The S.C. Cotton Museum in Bishopville first opened in 1995, but moved last year to a new location at 121 W. Cedar Lane. After a highly successful year in the 12,000 square foot building donated by Gold Kist Inc., the museum's organizers are celebrating their grand opening with a tribute to those who have worked to bring the museum to life.

"This celebration is to honor all of our volunteers and people who have donated money, time, artifacts and have helped us get the museum this far along," said Allene McCoy, co-founder of the museum. "This is our pay-back to people who have helped."

Allene expects more than 300 people at the celebration, which will begin at 6:30 p.m. on Friday and is open to the public. Hors d'oeuvres will be served, but the big event will be the unveiling of a new sculpture donated to the museum. Allen Sindler, a world-famous sculptor from Bishopville, sculpted a mobile butterfly to be placed outside in the museum's courtyard—a beautiful addition to the aesthetic setting there.

If you look at the museum's guest book, you'll see the names of people from all 50 states and from 17 foreign countries who have toured the history of cotton since Allene first opened the museum.

Ten-to-twelve people volunteer their time there, giving tours, manning the gift shop and keeping things in order. They are all crucial to the museum's upkeep, but so are the donations of antiques and artifacts.

"Everything has been donated, and people have been so generous," Allene said.

The museum is already filled with hundreds of farm items from our past—including a model tenant house and a real Cessna crop duster used to spray cotton fields for years. There is also a 4-foot tall boll weevil replica and an old cotton "mopper," which was used years ago to kill the weevils.

Because of the authenticity of the exhibits, the educational value held inside the museum is immeasurable. Out of the average 1000 visitors to the museum each month, most are school children. Not only do the children get a chance to see tools used by their ancestors who farmed, they get an education about agriculture. And, just to make sure the information sinks in, they take a "fun test" after their tours are over.

"That lets us know that they really did absorb the information," Allene said. "We hope to get all South Carolina children to take the tour."

When Allene began raising money for the museum, she knew she was taking on a colossal project. And it was worth it, because now we have a place to preserve the history of cotton in the state.

"The history of our early childhood is quickly disappearing," she said. "Part of the country's history and the history of agriculture and farming and many old, old things are being discarded and left by the wayside. This preservation lets children know how their great-grandparents lived—it's a link to the past."

I am grateful that Allene took this project upon herself; that the link has been established. This year's drought has been tough on our cotton farmers. Rains from Hurricane Floyd and other recent rains have helped some farmers, especially soybean farmers. However the rain came at a bad time for cotton farmers, and caused deterioration of some cotton bolls. It's more important than ever to show cotton farmers our support. Supporting low-interest loans for our farmers and federally-funded irrigation projects can help lessen the dramatic effects of a drought. If we do not support these measures, our farmers may opt for a life of less risk and sell their farms, in many cases to commercial developers. That's the last thing I would like to see happen.

Soybean referendum request begins

According to the Soybean Promotion and Research Program, an automatic producer review of the soybean checkoff program is required every five years. This automatic review provision in the law requires the U.S. Department of Agriculture to conduct a request for referendum. Individuals eligible to participate in the request for referendum are defined as any person engaged in the growing of soybeans in the United States who owns or shares ownership and risk of loss of such soybeans, specifically from Jan. 1, 1997 through Nov. 16, 1999.

Eligible individuals who do not want a referendum need not take any action.

Eligible individuals who desire a referendum may request such by completing Request Form LS-51-1, available from the Farm Service Agency (FSA) office in the county where FSA maintains and processes the producer's administrative farm records. Producers who do not participate in FSA programs may obtain a form at the county office that serves the county where the producer owns or rents land. Eligible individuals may obtain a form in person, by mail or by facsimile from Oct. 20, 1999 to Nov. 16, 1999. All completed forms must be returned by Nov. 16, 1999 to the FSA office, either in person or by facsimile. Forms returned by mail must be postmarked by Nov. 16, 1999 and received in the county FSA office by Dec. 1, 1999.

21st Annual Pumpkin Festival

You won't find any kiddie airplanes or twister rides at this festival. What you will find is old-fashioned family fun, complete with sack races and egg tosses.

The Pumpkin Festival, held in Pumpkintown on Oct. 9, is held each year to raise money for the community's volunteer fire department. But according to Festival President Buddy Cox, over the years the event has become a time for families to get together.

"It's sort-of like coming home every year," he said. "So many families that have moved away come back each year and bring their children. It's a down-home folksy festival and we try to keep that flavor year after year."

Cox said the secret to keeping that folksy flavor is keeping the event from becoming too commercial. That's why there are no carnival rides—only pony rides.

You can of course find many pumpkins for sale at

the festival, but there are also 130 arts and crafts booths, tons of food and more.

Pumpkin Bread

Ingredients: 1 1/2 cups sugar, 1 cup cooked or canned pumpkin, 1/2 cup vegetable oil, 1/2 cup water, 2 eggs, 1 2/3 cups all-purpose flour, 1 teaspoon baking soda, 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon, 3/4 teaspoon salt, 1/2 teaspoon baking powder, 1/2 teaspoon ground nutmeg, 1/4 teaspoon ground cloves, 1/2 cup chopped walnuts, 1/2 cup raisins, optional.

Directions: In a mixing bowl, combine sugar, pumpkin, oil, water and eggs, beat well. Combine dry ingredients; gradually add to pumpkin mixture and mix well. Stir in nuts and raisins, if desired. Pour into a greased 9"x5"x3" loaf pan. Bake at 350° for 65-70 minutes or until bread tests done. Cool 10 minutes in pan before removing to a wire rack.
