USDA Announces December Signup
Deadline for Conservation
Program Funding

Walter W. Douglas, SC state conservationist with the USDA Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS), announced priority funding deadlines for Farm Bill program assistance. Technical and financial assistance is available from four different conservation programs to help SC farmers and landowners protect soil and water resources.

The Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP) provides cost-sharing and incentive payments for conservation practices such as filter strips, nutrient management, waste management systems, waste utilization, grassed waterways, prescribed grazing, vegetative buffers, and wildlife habitat enhancement. There is a continuous signup underway with a December 15, 2002, priority-funding deadline.

The Conservation Reserve Program (CRP), administered by Farm Service Agency, helps farmers and landowners safeguard millions of acres of topsoil from erosion, increasing wildlife habitat, and protecting ground and surface water by reducing water runoff and sedimentation. There is a continuous signup underway and the possibility of a regular signup. More information will be forthcoming.

The Wildlife Habitat Incentives Program (WHIP) provides technical and financial assistance to landowners who want to develop and improve wildlife habitat primarily on private lands. There is a continuous signup underway with a December 15, 2002, priority-funding deadline.

The Wetlands Reserve Program (WRP) provides technical and financial assistance to eligible landowners to address wetland, wildlife habitat, soil, water, and related natural resource concerns on private lands in an environmentally beneficial and cost-effective manner. There is a continuous signup underway, but applicants are encouraged to apply by December 15, 2002, for priority funding.

Commissioner's Column

Alternative Fuels
for a Brighter Tomorrow

Everyday, we get out of bed, turn on the lights, and take a warm shower to get ready for the day. Then, we get in the car and drive to work. We don't have to think about what makes the lights come on, the water warm, or the car run. We take for granted that they will all work and do what they're supposed to do. But let the electricity go off or the car run out of gas, and we're completely lost. Without energy, life would be a significant challenge.

Most of our energy today comes from fossil fuel---coal, oil, and natural gas. Next to food, fossil fuel has been our most important source of energy. But, fossil fuel is not a renewable resource, so one day the fuel that we rely on now may no longer be available to meet our needs. However, there are alternative fuels for bioenergy.

Bioenergy is derived from plant material and animal waste. It's clean, efficient, and renewable. And, it uses any organic material produced by photosynthesis and available on a renewable basis. Bioenergy offers new markets for agriculture. Thanks in part to the soybean checkoff, farmers have developed a new use for their soybean oil by processing it into biodiesel. Corn farmers can do the same with their commodity to create ethanol.

Fuels for bioenergy can continually be renewed on agricultural land. They burn clean. They help reduce our dependence on foreign oil, increase conservation efforts, improve profit for farmers, and secure a brighter future for the nation. However, before more farmers grow more products for bioenergy, markets need to be developed for the end products.

The South Carolina Agricultural Council recently held an informative meeting on bioenergy. Krysta Harden of the American Soybean Association reported that there are billions of gallons of soybean oil sitting in storage that could be used for biodiesel fuel. Biodiesel can run in any diesel engine without modification to the engine. She added that biodiesel offers good performance and no emission. Unlike the black smoke of diesel fuel, the only emission from biodiesel fuel is the aroma of french fries. Experts say that if properly maintained, engines last longer on biodiesel fuel.

Ethanol, another alternative fuel for bioenergy, is a clean, colorless liquid that extends our petroleum supply, helping moderate fuel costs to consumers. Ethanol can be used by itself, or it can be mixed with gasoline to form gasohol. Over 1 billion gallons of ethanol are blended with gasoline every year in the United States. It is most commonly used in vehicles that are considered "flex-fuel" and can run on ethanol or gasoline. Since ethanol is produced from plants that harness the power of the sun, it is also considered a renewable fuel with many advantages as an automotive fuel.

So, why aren't we all using alternative fuels like biodiesel and ethanol? These biofuels cost a few cents more per gallon than fossil fuels, but the cost is relative when it comes to protecting our health and the environment. In the long run, it may cost us much more than a few cents. Our foreign suppliers have had us over a barrel, so to speak, for quite some time, since our nation uses about 26% of the world's supply of petroleum. That's almost 20 million barrels of the total 76 million barrels produced each day in the entire world.

Producing renewable fuels not only strengthens our national security, but it helps us keep our air clean while adding value to our traditional crops. Engines which use E85 fuel (85% ethanol and 15% gasoline) are now standard equipment on some cars and access to E85 fuel is becoming more accessible across the country. South Carolina now has an E85 and biodiesel station in Aiken, United Energy Distributors, owned and operated by Red Roberts.

As South Carolinians, we can help create jobs and economic activity, reduce our dependence on foreign oil, and improve the environment by developing alternate energy sources and supporting the use of biofuels whenever and wherever possible.
