Subject: Sabb Election Background

On September 2, 2014 Ronnie Sabb ran against Sam Floyd, Cezar E. McKnight, and Rep. Carl L. Anderson for the special primary election for the Senate District 32 seat vacated by Sen. McGill.

A candidate must receive 50 percent or more of all votes cast to receive the nomination. Ronnie Sabb came in second to Sam Floyd and a runoff was necessary.

Ronnie Sabb defeated Sam Floyd in the special Democratic Primary Runoff for Senate District 32 on Tuesday, September 16

The state Election Commission reported that Sabb's final tally was 9,648 to 6,774 for Sam L. Floyd.

It was reported that Sabb won all five districts in the county – Williamsburg, Georgetown, Florence, Horry and Berkeley.

Sabb will be the only candidate on the Nov. 4 general election ballot. No Republicans or others filed to run.
