SUMMARY REPORT

Meeting of Commission on Higher Education, August 27-28, 1984

The Commission approved an agreement concerning ways in which a portion of the \$750,000 appropriated to Winthrop College for 1984-85 for Winthrop's "Program for Effective Teaching" might be effectively shared with other institutions in the State through competitive grants to the colleges and universities for teacher training programs.

The Commission approved the following capital improvement requests: (1) Lease of Office Building on Liberty Street, College of Charleston, and (2) Lease of Space in Holiday Inn City Center, USC-Columbia.

The Commission approved the 1984-85 budget of the Charleston Higher Education Consortium in the amount of \$214,575.

The presidents of the public colleges and universities and the executive director of the State Board for Technical and Comprehensive Education presented their 1985-86 appropriation requests.
