The General Assembly is close to passing a bill that would significantly toughen SC's domestic-violence laws. After months of work and debate, the House/Senate compromise legislation includes a lifetime ban on possessing guns for those convicted of the most serious offenses. The House unanimously passed a compromise bill that would double the potential prison time for domestic abuse to as long as 20 years. If the changes approved by the House become law, the level of domestic-abuse charge would be based on the severity of an attack, rather than the number of times a person has been charged with the crime. It also targets education requiring teaching domestic-violence prevention to middle-schoolers. The bill heads back to the Senate where one leader says he's confident the Legislature will pass. This domestic-violence bill needs to be completed before the session ends June 4. Senate Approves 19 Week Abortion Ban

The Senate outmaneuvered a filibuster and passed a compromise on an anti-abortion bill on a vote of 37-7.
