The regular monthly meeting of the Department of Transportation Commission was held at the headquarters building in Columbia, South Carolina at 10:00 a.m. on February 20, 2003. In compliance with the Freedom of Information Act, the news media was advised in writing of the time, date and place of this meeting.

SECTION 1: The Minutes for the meeting of January 14, 2003; copies of which had been previously mailed to each member of the Commission, were approved.

SECTION 2: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the sale of surplus right of way property, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 3: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to advertise, select and negotiate with consulting firms to provide a statewide study of non-metal truss bridges, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 4: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department in rescinding it's action in adding roads to the State Highway System, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 5: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department in removing roads from the State Highway System, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 6: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department in the removal of roads, by court order, from the State Highway System and shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 7: The Commission unanimously passed a motion of the Department in adding roads to the State Highway System, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 8: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department concerning projects in the December 17, 2003 highway letting and shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 9: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department concerning projects in the January 14, 2003 highway letting and shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 10: On behalf of the Invitations and Resolutions Committee, Commissioner Stoddard reported that the committee had the following requests:

- Alexander H. Buchanan Bridge 596
- J. Foster Jeffords Memorial Causeway 595

A motion was made by Commissioner Stoddard and seconded by Commissioner Truluck to approve these requests. The motion passed unanimously.

SECTION 11: On behalf of the SCDOT Special Committee on State Highway Funding, Commissioner Clyborne made a motion to adopt the committee's recommendations, which are shown in detail in the Appendix. Commissioner Harrell seconded the motion and the Commission unanimously approved.

SECTION 12: On motion of Commissioner Truluck, seconded by Commissioner Stoddard, the Commission unanimously passed a resolution requiring South Carolina counties and municipalities to make bicycling and pedestrian improvements an integral part of their transportation planning and programming where State or Federal Highway funding is utilized. A copy of the resolution is shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 13: On motion of Commissioner Truluck, seconded by Commissioner Mack, the Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the Revised FY'04 Earmark and Reauthorization Requests list, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 14: On motion of Commissioner Mack, seconded by Commissioner Hardee, the Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the FY '03-'04 Appropriation Budget, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 15: Chairman Martin called for nominations for the office of First Vice Chairman. Commissioner Truluck nominated Commissioner Mack. Commissioner Stoddard seconded the nomination. Commissioner Hardee moved that the nominations be closed and Commissioner Mack was elected First Vice Chairman by acclamation.

SECTION 16: The next order of business was the election of a Second Vice Chairman. Commissioner Clyborne nominated Commissioner Harrell. Commissioner Hardee seconded. The nominations were closed and Commissioner Harrell was elected Second Vice Chairman by acclamation.

SECTION 17: On behalf of the members of the Commission, Commissioner Mack presented a resolution to Chairman Martin recognizing and commending him for his outstanding service as chairman of the South Carolina Department of Transportation Commission. A copy of the resolution is shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 18: There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting was adjourned at 11:05 a.m.

1. File 23.277A / SC Route 14 (Pelham Road) / Greenville County

During construction of improvements on SC Route 14 (Pelham Road), under File 23.277A in Greenville County, near the City of Greer, the Department acquired right of way for the improvement of SC Route 14 (Pelham Road) and Roscoe Drive intersection by Condemnation of tracts 95 and 96 from Phillip J. Prezestrzelski, Donna Prezestrzelski and Linda Loughlin dated November 5, 1999.

A request was received from Carolinda M. Robinson requesting the small remainders of tracts 95 and 96 adjacent to her property. The small remainders separate Mrs. Robinson's property from Roscoe Drive. The request was circulated to the Engineering sections to determine if said parcels could be declared surplus. After review it was determined that the parcels were surplus to Department needs. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.4 of an acre of land to Carolinda M. Robinson in consideration of \$18,000.00 was executed on November 25, 2002.

2. File 23.352A / Road S-272 / Greenville County

During construction of improvements on Road S-272, under File 23.352A in Greenville County, near the Town of Four Shoals, the Department acquired right of way for the improvement of Road S-272 by Construction Act 36 in 1959 and was accepted into the South Carolina Department of Transportation Highway System on September 17, 1959.

A request was received from the adjacent property owners asking the Department to sell a parcel of abandoned right of way located in front of their property. The subject parcel is a landlocked remainder that separates the requester's property frontage from the new right of way of Road S-272. The request was circulated to the engineering sections to determine if said parcel could be declared surplus. After review it was determined that the parcel was surplus to Department needs. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.47 of an acre of land to Patricia H. Castleman and Mary H. Wiggs in consideration of \$4,000.00 was executed on November 25, 2002.

3. File 10.882 / Road S-20 / Charleston County

During construction of improvements on Road S-20, under File 10.882 in Charleston County, near the City of Charleston, the Department acquired right of way for the improvement of Road S-20 by Title to Real Estate from Benjamin & Edwina Green dated August 11, 1997 and from TC & Jessica Bernados by Condemnation dated February 23, 1998.

During negotiations to settle a difficult condemnation case, the Department agreed to convey a small parcel of adjacent surplus property and reduce the 23-meter (75.46-foot) right of way line to a 16.5 meter (54-foot) right of way line in front of the Grantee's property. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for a total of approximately 0.17 of an acre of land to T.C. & Jessica Bernados was executed on December 6, 2002.

4. File 42.512A / US Route 176 / Spartanburg County

During construction of improvements on US Route 176, under File 42.512A in Spartanburg County, near the City of Spartanburg, the Department acquired right of way for the improvement of US Route 176 by Title to Real Estate from H.G. Lemaster dated March 7, 1957.

While negotiating to settle a difficult acquisition case, the Department agreed to convey an adjacent surplus parcel to the Grantee as full payment for the new right of way needed for the project. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.3 of an acre of land to Li'l Crickett, LLC was executed on December 6, 2002.

5. File 21.615 / Road S-1041 & Road S-876/ Florence County

During construction of improvements on Road S-1041 and Road S-876, under File 21.615 in Florence County, near the Town of Pamplico, the Department acquired right of way for Road S-1041 and Road S-876, by Construction Act, Section 33-106.1 and accepted the roads into the South Carolina Department of Highway system on October 15, 1970; also, from the Town of Pamplico by Dedication dated September 24, 1971.

A request was received from the District 5, District Engineering Administrator on behalf of the Florence County School District No. 2 asking the Department to abandoned and convey portions of Roads S-1041 and S-876. Since the Department brought these roads in the system under the Construction Act from the Town of Pamplico, and the school district has completed a road closure action at SCDOT's request it is appropriate to convey this property gratis. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately a total of 1.36 of an acre of land to Florence County School District No.2 was executed on December 3, 2002.

6. File 23.276A / SC Route 418/Greenville County

During construction of improvements on SC Route 418 relocation, under File 23.276A in Greenville County, near the Town of Fountain Inn, the Department acquired right of way for SC Route 418, by Title to Real Estate from Frank B. Cameron dated August 18, 1997.

The Department received a request from James Cashion, Jr., to sell him a small triangle parcel of land that is a small remainder from another property that separates his land from the new right of way of relocated SC Route 418. The request was circulated to the Engineering sections to determine if said parcel could be declared surplus. After review it was determined that the parcel was surplus to Department needs. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.08 of an acre of land to James E. Cashion, Jr. in consideration of \$1,000.00 was executed on November 25, 2002.

7. File MSC 10 / SC Route 6/ Lexington County

In order to better perform its maintenance responsibilities, the Department purchased MSC 10 in Lexington County, near the Town of Swansea. The Department acquired the Swansea Maintenance Site by Title to Real Estate from H.M. Sharpe dated January 28, 1948.

The District Engineering Administrator of District 1, with the concurrence of management, has determined that the Swansea Maintenance site is no longer needed and should be liquidated from the Department's inventory. After receiving approval from the South Carolina Budget and Control Board, the property was marketed to the general public with signs, newspaper ads, and all necessary means to attract a qualified buyer. A bid sale was set up and consummated. The Grantee offered the highest acceptable bid over the appraised value of \$23,600.00. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 1.97 acres of land to Floyd Vernon Chandler, III was executed on December 17, 2002 in consideration of \$24,101.00.

8. File 23.176A / Road S-510 / Greenville County

During construction of improvements on Road S-510 (Congaree Road) under File 23.176A in Greenville County, near the City of Greenville, the Department acquired right of way by Beltline Act 36-1959 and was accepted into the South Carolina Highway system on May 16, 1963.

A portion of Old Congaree Road has been relocated as Woods Lake Road producing a small parcel of abandoned right of way. A request was received from the adjacent property owner asking the Department to sell the old abandoned right of way that is landlocked and divides his property. The request was circulated to the engineering sections to determine if the said parcel could be declared surplus. After review it was determined that the parcel was surplus to the Department needs. Therefore, a Quitclaim deed for approximately 0.375 of an acre of land to WLR Holdings, LLC was executed on December 30, 2002 in consideration of \$1,000.00

9. File 23.286A / SC Route 146 / Greenville County

During construction of improvements on Road S-145 under File 23.286A in Greenville County, near the City of Greenville, the Department acquired right of way by Beltline Act and was accepted into the South Carolina Highway system on June 28, 1945 and from L.L. Green by Condemnation dated June 10, 1958.

Improvements were made along SC Route 146 resulting in the realignment of Road S-145 and SC Route 296. A request was received from an adjacent property owner requesting a portion of Old Road S-145 and Old SC Route 296. The request was circulated to the engineering sections to determine if the said parcel could be declared surplus. After review it was determined that the parcel was surplus to the Department needs. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.42 of an acre of land to Nancy N. Hudson, Trustee of Jesse A. Neeley was executed on December 30, 2002 in consideration of \$18,363.00.

10. File 40.614A / Road S-52 (Clemson Road) / Richland County

During construction of improvements on Road S-52 under File 40.614A in Richland County, near the City of Columbia, the Department acquired right of way by Right of Way Easement from Clemson College dated February 2, 1960, by Title to Real Estate from Clemson University dated May 15, 2000 and by Quitclaim Deed from Clemson University dated August 20, 2002.

An agreement was made between the Department and Alan Kahn Development, to convey the old right of way for the present Road S-52 (Clemson Road) along with the retention pond constructed under File 40.614A. The deed includes a special provision whereby the Grantee agrees to maintain the current retention pond to the Department's standards and has accepted any future liability associated with the pond. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 12 acres of land to Village at Sandhill, LLC was executed on December 30, 2002 in consideration of \$60,000.00

11. File 10.508 / SC Route 642 / Charleston County

During construction of improvements on SC Route 642 (Dorchester Road) under File 10.508 in Charleston County, near the City of Charleston, the Department acquired right of way by Right of Way Easement from SCE&G dated June 5, 1962.

A request was received from the adjacent property owner asking to purchase a small parcel of right of way (Dorsey Street) in front of his business in order to make improvements to the abandoned roadbed and drainage. The request was circulated to the engineering sections to determine if the said parcel could be declared surplus. After review it was determined that the parcel could be sold under the following conditions: 1) The deed will include a Reverter Clause so that the Department can reclaim title to the property anytime it deems necessary. 2) Any additional work on the road and drainage must be approved by the SCDOT. The Grantee has agreed to these conditions. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.11 of an acre of land to Philip Schoonover was executed on December 30, 2002 in consideration of \$15,700.00.

12. File 37.2000 / Road S-1 (Clemson Highway) / Oconee County

During construction of improvements on Road S-1 (Clemson Highway) under File 37.2000 in Oconee County, near the Town of Seneca, the Department acquired right of way by Beltline Act and was accepted into the South Carolina Highway System on August 20, 1920 and from Ruth W. Royal by Condemnation dated December 12, 1955, also by Deed to Right of Way from Clemson Agricultural College dated November 14, 1955-File 37.367.

During negotiations to acquire new right of way for the above project, the Department agreed to exchange the old abandoned right of way of Road S-1 (Clemson Highway) to the Grantee in exchange for the new right of way needed for the relocation of Road S-1. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 1.4 acres of land to Edwards Land Management, Inc. was executed on December 30, 2002.

13. File 37.229 / SC Route 59 / Oconee County

During construction of improvements on SC Route 59 under File 37.229 in Oconee County, near the Town of Fair Play, the Department acquired right of way by Condemnation from S.A. Glenn dated November 7, 1940.

A request was received from C. B. Busbee, District 3 Engineering Administrator, to reduce a 100-foot by 100-foot triangle. The request was circulated to the engineering sections and it was determined that the triangle could be reduced. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.05 of an acre of land to Larry C. & Melissa L. Wilkerson was executed on January 2, 2003 in consideration of \$1,000.00.

14. File 32.947 / US Route 378 / Lexington County

During construction of improvements on US Route 378 under File 32.947 in Lexington County, near the City of Lexington, the Department acquired right of way by Title to Real Estate from Richard & William T. Edgerton dated November 3, 1997.

A request was received from the adjacent property owner asking to purchase a small piece of right of way that the Department acquired to build a sediment pond, but was never built. The request was circulated to the Engineering sections to determine if the said parcel could be declared surplus. After review, it was determined that the parcel was surplus to the Department needs. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.22 of an acre of land to William Robert & Susan S, Mosier was executed on January 2, 2003.

15. File 7.597(27.518) / SC Route 170 / Jasper County

During construction of improvements on SC Route 170 under File 27.518 in Jasper County, near the Town of Garrets Point, the Department acquired right of way that included an area for an outfall ditch by Condemnation from Robert W. Sanders, Jr.

In order to settle a difficult condemnation case, the Department agreed to pay \$51,000.00 for approximately 1.416 acres of land (\$36,000.00 per acre). As part of the settlement the Department agreed to reduce the amount of property condemned, being the right of way for the outfall ditch, and agreed to convey that property back to the Grantee (Condemnee). The value of the property being quitclaimed is \$22,320.00 resulting in a cost savings to the Department for that amount. This action will eliminate the severance damages as well as allow the Grantee access to the median. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.62 of an acre of land to Robert W. Sanders was executed on January 2, 2003

16. File 23.276A / SC Route 418 Relocation / Greenville County

The Department acquired right of way for Road S-217 by Beltline Act 824, dated 1952, at no cost to the Department and accepted the road into the South Carolina Highway system on June 21, 1956. During construction of improvements on SC Route 418 Relocation, under File 23.276A in Greenville County, near the Town of Fountain Inn, a portion of Road S-217 was realigned.

A request was received from the Grantee requesting a small remainder of Old Road S-217 adjacent to his property. This parcel of abandoned right of way separates his land from the new SC Route 418. The request was circulated to the engineering sections to determine if the said parcel could be declared surplus. After review, it was determined that the parcel was surplus to the Department needs. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.13 of an acre of land to Marion Beasley was executed on January 2, 2003 in consideration of \$1,950.00.

17. File 23.458A / SC Route 146 / Greenville County

During construction of improvements on SC Route 146, under File 23.458A in Greenville County, near the City of Mauldin, the Department acquired right of way by Condemnation from S.C. Bradley dated June 6, 1956 and by Condemnation from A.H. Godfrey Estate dated June 6, 1956.

The Department had acquired right of way previously on the above project by condemnation at no cost for the parcel. The Bradley Oaks Homeowners Association had a very expensive decorative wall built whereby the contractor inadvertently constructed the wall on the right of way at the entrance of the subdivision. It was decided, with concurrence from the engineering departments, that the small parcels of right of way and wall should be deeded to the association due to the expensive replacement cost of the wall and to avoid liability to the Department. The deed contains a Reverter Clause allowing the Department to reacquire the parcels at no cost or damages for the wall. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.263 of an acre of land to Bradley Oaks Homeowners Association was executed on January 2, 2003.

18. File MSC 76 / SC Route 34 / Fairfield County

The Department acquired 1.0 acre (43,560 sq. ft.) of land at a cost of \$100.00 to construct a maintenance operations facility, MSC 76, in Fairfield County, near Salem Crossroads by Title to Real Estate from Ernest B. Crawford dated April 9, 1938.

The District Engineering Administrator of District 4, with concurrence of management, has determined that the Maintenance Shed near Salem Crossroads is no longer needed and should be liquidated from the Department's inventory. After receiving approval from the South Carolina Department Budget and Control Board, the property was marketed to the general public with signs, newspaper ads, and all necessary means to attract a qualified buyer. A bid sale was set up and consummated. The Grantee offered the highest acceptable bid higher than the appraised value of \$6,000.00. Therefore a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 1.0 acre of land to Quay W. Mc Master in consideration of \$6,500.00 was executed on December 30, 2002.

19. File 32.912.1 / US Route 1 / Lexington County

During construction of improvements on Road S-113, under File 32.572 in Lexington County, near the Town of Gilbert, the Department acquired 0.23 of an acre (10018 sq. ft.) of right of way at no cost to the Department for Road S-113, by Condemnation from Mrs. Belle M. Reeder dated June 16, 1971.

Improvements were made at the intersection of US Route 1 and Road S-113 under file 32.912.1 in which Road S-113 was realigned creating abandoned right of way. A request was received from Zuleime L. Martin requesting the small remainder of abandoned right of way. The request was circulated to the Engineering sections to determine if said parcel could be declared surplus. After review it was determined that the parcel was surplus to Department needs. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.04 of an acre of land to Zuleime L. Martin in consideration of \$1,000.00 was executed on December 30, 2002.

20. File 26.843 / SC Route 707 / Horry County

The Department acquired right of way for SC Route 707 by Beltline Act and accepted the road into the South Carolina Department of Transportation's Highway System October 1, 1920. During construction of improvements on SC Route 707, under File 26.843 in Horry County, near the City of Myrtle Beach, a portion of SC Route 707 was realigned creating surplus property.

A request was received from Joseph L. Tamsberg, Jr. requesting two small remainders of Old SC Route 707 adjacent to his property. These parcels of abandoned right of way separate the requester's land from the new SC Route 707. The request was circulated to the Engineering sections to determine if said parcel could be declared surplus. After review, it was determined that the parcel was surplus to Department needs. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.65 of an acre of land to Joseph L. Tamsberg, Jr. in consideration of \$30,365.00 was executed on January 8, 2003.

REQUEST FOR CONSULTANTS TO PERFORM STATEWIDE SURVEY OF BRIDGES

To expedite project development, the Department requests Commission approval to advertise, select and negotiate with consulting firms to provide a statewide study of non-metal truss bridges. This study is needed to expedite federal requirements for the removal of historically significant bridges. The Department does not have the staff or the expertise that this study requires. This project is working in conjunction with the South Carolina State University Transportation Center.

The agreement with the consultant will cover three phases of the survey. After each phase is completed, the work will be reviewed and approved before authorization is granted to proceed with the next phase.

SCDOT Special Committee on State Highway Funding

The Committee has reviewed numerous reports and statistical data regarding the status of state-source highway funding in South Carolina, and we believe that the funding shortfall has reached a crisis level. Addressing this crisis should be made a priority issue for our state. It is critical to the safety of motorists, and to the state's future economic development and wellbeing that action is taken as quickly as possible. Further, we believe the Legislature should consider past shortfalls and future needs in its deliberations and the resulting action taken to address the state's transportation funding shortfall.

Therefore, it is the recommendation of the Committee that the SCDOT Commission adopt the following position:

SCDOT requests the Legislature to consider a comprehensive and long range approach to funding the state's current transportation needs.

Funding for transportation should be addressed as quickly as possible.

Additional sources of funding should be identified and provided to supplement Motor Fuel User fee revenues.

The current Motor Fuel User Fee should be increased to an amount per gallon that is more closely in line with that of our neighboring states, based on number of miles of highways in the state system and revenue amount generated per penny.

The Motor Fuel Use Fee should be automatically adjusted on a regular basis in order to keep up with cost escalations or inflation.

Any additional revenues, along with current revenues received by SCDOT, should be dedicated to the Highway Trust Fund and protected from transfer for other purposes. The additional funds will be used for safety improvements, resurfacing and maintenance of the existing state highway system in all counties, to include both rural and urban areas. SCDOT will give top priority the approximate 25,000 miles of highways, generally the secondary roads that are not eligible for federal funds.

SCDOT should be granted the ability to issue revenue bonds, which would give the agency an additional method of leveraging state and local transportation funding.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, increasing walking and bicycling offers the potential for cleaner air, greater health of the population, reduced traffic congestion, more livable communities, less reliance on fossil fuels and their foreign supply sources and more efficient use of road space and resources; and

WHEREAS, in 2001 crashes involving bicyclists and pedestrians represented 13 percent of the traffic fatalities in S.C. and in the U.S.; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) in its February 24, 1999 Policy statement "Guidance on the Bicycle and Pedestrian Provisions of the Federal-Aid Program" urges states to include bicycle and pedestrian accommodations routinely in their programmed highway projects; and

WHEREAS, bicycle and pedestrian projects and programs are eligible for funding from almost all of the major Federal-aid funding programs; and

WHEREAS, the South Carolina Department of Transportation Commission is strongly committed to improving conditions for walking and bicycling; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century (TEA-21) calls for the mainstreaming of bicycle and pedestrian projects into the planning, design and operation of our Nation's transportation system;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the South Carolina Department of Transportation Commission in meeting duly assembled this 14th day of January 2003, affirms that bicycling and walking accommodations should be a routine part of the department's planning, design, construction and operating activities, and will be included in the everyday operations of our transportation system; and

THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the South Carolina Department of Transportation Commission requires South Carolina counties and municipalities to make bicycling and pedestrian improvements an integral part of their transportation planning and programming where State or Federal Highway funding is utilized.



State Match Construction




