As you are aware, I had unfortunate driving situation that landed me with a DUI on my driving record from a Christmas Party. This has been quite the experience but I have been trying to move on with my life since this horrible unfortunate situation/experience.

First, I was told that my "Implied Consent" was dismissed and I could get a provisional license. Then, I get to the DMV and was told that is not true.

Then, I was told that once I enrolled in ADSAP then I could get a temporary license and/or route restricted. Then, I get to the DMV and was told that is not true.

Then, I was told I needed SR22 in order to get a temporary license. Then, I get to the DMV and was told that is not true.

Then, I was told by you that I needed an IID device if I wanted to get driving privileges before the suspension is over. I installed an IID device. I had to drive three hours to get this done because nobody in my area could help me. Then, I get to the DMV on Friday and they told me that is not true. They would not issue a license.

Ms. Rivers, as you can tell, I have been through a nightmare. I understand that I have a charge on my driving record but I am not a bad person. I am self employed and work 6 and 7 days a week. I take care of my family. I work hard to make sure I have a successful career for me and my family. I don't know what else to do. This matter is before the South Carolina Office of Motor Vehicle Hearings (OMVH) pursuant to Respondent's request for a contested case hearing regarding the suspension of Respondent's driver's license or driving privilege. Pursuant to notice to the parties, a hearing was scheduled to be held before me on February 1, 2016 at the Horry County Historical Court House in Conway, South Carolina.


On November 10, 2015, Fran Humphries, Esquire of the City of North Myrtle Beach sent an e-mail to the OMVH which noted that the City of North Myrtle Beach did not wish to enter testimony/evidence into the record in reference to the above-captioned case. Pursuant to Rule 13 of the Rules of Procedure of the Office of Motor Vehicle Hearings, a case may be dismissed adverse to a defaulting party when the party fails to appear or to offer testimony/evidence at the hearing to prosecute or defend the case.

Accordingly, since there is no longer a contested case before me, the hearing scheduled for February 1, 2016 is **CANCELLED**.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above-captioned case is dismissed, and the Respondent's driver's license or driving privilege is reinstated; and it is further

ORDERED that upon Respondent's compliance with the laws of this State, the Petitioner (SCDMV) must immediately **RESTORE** the Respondent's driver's license or driving privilege.

AND IT IS SO ORDERED.


