Need to get Gov. Haley's reaction to the fact that an organization called the Atlantic Institute of South Carolina (also called the SC Dialogue Foundation), which has offices in both Columbia and Greenville (where It also runs a school), is linked to and follows the teachings of Fethullah Gulen, the Muslim Cleric who now lives in Pennsylvania and is accused by Turkish President Erdogan of fermenting last week's failed but bloody coup in that country. Members of this organization have met with Haley's cabinet members – notably the Deputy Secretary of Commerce <http://www.scdialogue.org/index.php/about-us/multimedia> - and have toured the statehouse where they met with legislators and cabinet officers and visited Gov. Haley's office. The group also has taken many members of the legislature on all expense paid informational trips to Turkey. They also attended Gov. Haley's holiday reception at the mansion on December 13, 2011.
