Governor,

We received detailed updates from Commerce and PRT today. I have attached both reports, but in general, we are making incremental progress on both fronts. For Commerce, we have a number of significant employers who are still working through power and workforce issues. For example, Fred Gretsches Enterprises in Jasper County is without power, Balchem in Colleton County has ½ power through generators, and Carpenter Technology in Chesterfield Power has a sewer pump down. In addition, a number of retailers and smaller businesses are still being impacted by utility outages and workforce issues. For PRT, Huntington Beach had power and water restored, and downed trees have been limbed since their last update. Charles Towne Landing reopened today with power and sewer service. Edisto and Myrtle Beach remain closed, but have power and water service.
