The State Budget and Control Board met in the Office of the State Auditor at 10:30 A. M. on November 21, 1958.

The Board considered a tentative Budget and revenue estimates prepared by the State Auditor according to policies agreed upon by the Board. After a full discussion, and the adoption of changes agreed upon by the Board, the budget was approved, and the State Auditor was directed to proceed with preparation of the Report.

The Board approved an allocation of \$1,000.00 to the Legislative Committee on Inland Waters, and of \$1,250.00 to the Senatorial Research Committee.

The Board declined to approve an allocation of \$985.76 to the Industrial Commission for trading automobiles.

The Board approved an additional \$140,000.00 to be placed in the Budget Request for completion of renovations of the State House.

The Board also approved the purchase of property and land on Senate Street not to exceed a total of \$192,500.00.

The Board also approved the working out of an agreement on the Bettis Academy property after consultation with Senator Timmerman.

The Board also recommended that the Attorney General's department give a ruling on the sale of marshlands desired by Ben Scott Whaley of Charleston.

At the same time, the Board approved the renovation of the Governor's Office in the Wade Hampton State Office Building, and that the necessary money be paid out of the Insurance Fund of the Sinking Fund Commission, and added to the cost of the Wade Hampton State Office Building, and the amount amortized over the necessary period of years.

The Board then adjourned.
