- WHEREAS,** South Carolina traces its automotive roots back nearly 100 years when Milliken & Company made fabric seats and roofs for Henry Ford's gasoline-powered cars; and
- WHEREAS,** today, South Carolina is home to approximately 400 automotive-related companies and suppliers, and the automotive industry has quadrupled in two decades; and
- WHEREAS,** the automotive sector represents over 2.5 percent of the state's employment base, playing a fundamental role in South Carolina's economy with a total impact of over \$27 billion; and
- WHEREAS,** the Palmetto State ranks first in the nation for exports of finished automobiles and number one in exports of tires with 30 percent of the U.S. market share; and
- WHEREAS,** South Carolina is home to the only graduate degree program for automotive engineering in the United States at Clemson University's International Center for Automotive Research.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim February 21 - 27, 2016, as
