Consumers as well as farmers would be affected by the Kyoto Protocol. The hidden danger of the treaty is that everything we eat, wear, or use requires energy to produce. If the cost of energy is dramatically increased, every citizen will be forced to pay higher prices. If the United States signs on to the treaty, the cost of gasoline is expected to increase by 50 percent and electricity by 50 to 80 percent. Also, we are constantly encouraging economic expansion and development within our borders, but businesses would ultimately look overseas for more affordable goods and services. The loss of those businesses would mean the loss of much needed jobs and revenue as well as marketing outlets for our agricultural products.

Today, I ask each citizen of the state to take a stand on this treaty---if not for agriculture, then for yourselves and your families. Until there is a consensus on what actually causes global warming, we can’t bet the health and welfare of this state and nation on such a treaty. We must show our support for the strong resistance to the Kyoto Protocol. It’s a flawed policy that will do more harm than long-term good. I urge everyone to fight this treaty. **Contact your Congressmen and Senators in Washington before the storm hits home. This is serious business. Don’t delay. Do it now!**
