Thank you again for taking the time to listen to my story this morning.

As you requested, I am attaching a copy of the Agreement to Arbitrate that I was forced to sign.

Please note that Rule 60 Motion is something that needs to be looked at, it states that "arbitration can only be utilized in the areas of property or alimony." Mark Taylor argument is that "because it does not state that children's issues can't be Arbitrated, they are allowed to do so with parents consent." Parent's cannot consent to give their children's Constitutional Rights away. Mr. Grady Query or Mike Sautter, my attorneys in Charleston have copies of that.

It's the same with what Judge Morris ruled in our hearing with citing Rule 4 from SCADR.
