Front-gabled barn located approximately 80 feet northwest of Resource 0255. There are two main sections, an enclosed portion to the west which is clad in weatherboard and vertical wood siding, and a large open section on the east. The enclosed section is fenestrated with a wood screen door and two wood frame windows, one of which appears to be a composite of three two-over-two double-hung sashes. The open section has square wood supports with simple brackets and an enclosed gable end that is clad in vertical wood siding. The building has a post-in-hole foundation and exposed rafter tails.
