To qualify for Board Membership, a candidate must be a resident of South Carolina and of the District wherein nominated, over the age of 25 years, having been engaged in producing hogs within the State of South Carolina for a period of five years, and during that period, having derived a substantial portion of his income therefrom.

Any producer within the District wherein nominating who sold hogs during the past year is entitled to participate in the meeting.

District I includes the Counties of Anderson, Cherokee, Chester, Chesterfield, Fairfield, Greenville, Kershaw, Lancaster, Laurens, Newberry, Oconee, Pickens, Spartanburg, Union and York.

District II includes the Counties of Abbeville, Aiken, Allendale, Bamberg, Barnwell, Beaufort, Calhoun, Edgefield, Greenwood, Hampton, Jasper, Lexington, McCormick, Orangeburg, Richland, and Saluda.

District III includes the Counties of, Berkeley, Charleston, Clarendon, Colleton, Darlington, Dillon, Dorchester, Florence, Georgetown, Horry, Lee, Marion, Marlboro, Sumter and Williamsburg.

Under said Marketing Order, oral nominations, seconded by no less than five (5) qualified producers, for qualified candidates shall be accepted by the Commission. Nominations may also be made within five (5) working days after each said District meeting by written petition filed with the Commission and signed by not less than five (5) affected producers entitled to participate in such meeting. The term of office of the members election and/or appointed to fill said vacancies shall be three (3) years.

Commissioner's Column

High Petroleum Prices Add Fuel to the Fire

As fuel prices rise this summer, many South Carolinians are thinking twice about their travel plans. Not only are vacationers faced with high fuel costs, but truckers and shippers in SC are facing hard times from the soaring prices, too, which places an added financial burden on agriculture and agribusiness.

According to the SC Trucking Association, 81% of SC's communities are served exclusively by trucks. In addition, trucks supply goods to over 1500 agricultural businesses and deliver produce and products to markets. When looking at these numbers, it is obvious how important the trucking industry is to our state.

In 1997 alone, 201 million tons of freight was transported into and out of South Carolina by truck, a great deal of which was agriculturally based. This can be an expensive endeavor, especially now that fuel costs are affecting the entire trucking industry. Rick Todd, president of the SC Trucking Association, said that there is a capacity crunch in the industry. Not only that, but independent contractors are turning in their trucks due to high fuel prices. With costs still on the rise, how can the industry survive?

According to Todd, the trucking contractors may need to build in fuel escalation charges in their contracts that adjust according to the current costs. That increase will affect the price of transporting agricultural products. Diesel, the most principally used truck fuel, makes up about 67% of the gallons used, with only 33% gasoline. Transport Topics, the trucking industry's electronic newspaper, reported that one year ago diesel fuel prices were at 143.1 cents per gallon. As of Monday June 4, it was up to 151.4 cents per gallon, just slightly down from May's high of 153.

So, what does this all mean for the industry? Legislation has been in the works allowing truckers to have mandatory fuel surcharges during periods of fuel price spikes. In the June issue of a produce publication, The Packer, Jim Johnston, president of the Owner -Operator Independent Drivers Association, stated that the only way for truckers, especially independent contractors, to reach economic stability is to have some sort of fuel charge legislation.

A surcharge will directly affect the agricultural industry. In 2000, the Department of Agricultural and Applied Economics at Clemson University reported on the impact of escalating fuel prices as a direct relation to calf prices. The correlation was staggering. According to the study, since the cattle producers are at the end of the marketing channel, they can't pass the cost increase along. So, if fuel costs were to increase from \$1.25-\$2.50 per gallon, for example, then the change in transportation cost would be from \$30.51 to \$34.84 per head. Although this may not seem much at first, if you multiply that cost by a 100-head herd, the resulting cost difference would be hard for cattle producers to tackle.

In addition to higher costs for transporting agricultural goods, production costs at the farm level are directly proportionate with the cost of fuel. Farmers use diesel, for the most part, in farm equipment. And, others need propane to operate their farming facilities. Many of the herbicides and insecticides are petroleum-based products.

While agriculture is a fuel consumer, it could also be an enormous source of biomass to produce liquid fuels. Biofuels is now an accepted alternative source of fuel and provides an additional market for soybeans, corn, sweet potatoes, and other crops. However, accessibility and availability of biofuels is an issue as well as the price. With the current fuel crisis, the gap has narrowed somewhat between the cost of petroleum and biofuels, but accessibility is still an obstacle.

Higher fuel costs affect everyone, especially the agricultural and trucking industries. With no immediate relief on the horizon, many shippers and truckers are facing difficult decisions, as are farmers. Farm level prices for raw products are low and production prices for farm machinery and supplies continue to rise. And, adding fuel to the fire is the high price of petroleum products.

In addition to farmers and truckers, South Carolinians will also encounter higher costs as they prepare to travel for the Fourth of July holiday. I encourage you to save by traveling in state. There are many beautiful sights to see here in South Carolina, from our rolling foothills and state parks to our beaches. There is something in SC for everyone to see.

Fresh sweet corn is one of South Carolina’s summer highlights, but most folks like to enjoy it year-round. So Mrs. Les Tindal, “Miss May,” once again shares her favorite recipe for freezing corn off the cob:

Take 20 cups of corn, 5 cups ice water, 1/4 cup salt, 1/4 - 3/4 cups sugar (to individual taste), mix well, put into a container and freeze. Blanching is *not* required. Thaw and pour off excess water before cooking.
