While reviewing NAPIS reports, AAA staff are finding a large number of clients listed in AIM as "Urban", when in fact it should be rural. AT the July 17 meeting, it was stated that the AAA's were going to be able to determine "rural" or "urban" rather than the zip code designation.

Is it still the thought of the LGOA? When users attempt to input "urban" or "rural" into the AIM system, that part is grayed out and the user can't make that designation.

The current NAPIS report is not going to show the true amount of rural clients served this past federal fiscal year.
