The following departments and institutions appeared before the Commission in connection with their requests for appropriations for the year 1942-43:


State Hospital

The Commissioner of Agriculture requested an allotment from the Civil Contingent Fund of \$1,000.00 to partly defray the expenses of the National Association of Commissioners, Secretaries and Directors of Agriculture, to meet in Columbia early in November. The Commission authorized ^a ~~the~~ transfer for this purpose from the appropriation for oil testing equipment carried in the 1941-42 appropriation account for the Department of Agriculture.
