Martha,

Attached please find a draft of H-3983 with amendments. Also, Catherine wanted me to include the "Solomon" language in this email in case you needed it:

Notwithstanding the provisions of the Certification of Need and Health Facility Licensure Act

("Act"), any person or health care facility that undertook or had a need to undertake a project between July 1, 2013, and June 30, 2014, which would have required a Certificate of Need shall be awarded a Certificate of Need by the Department within thirty (30) days of submission to the Department of a statement that the project is or was needed, unless an opposition to the project is timely filed by an affected person. Any person or healthcare facility seeking a Certificate of Need pursuant to this provision must submit a statement to the Department by June 30, 2014, with a brief description of the project and a brief statement of the need. The Department shall notice the statement on the date of receipt.

Unless an affected person submits a written opposition to the project to the Department within thirty days of the date of notice, the Department shall automatically award the Certificate of Need. If opposition to the noticed project is received by the Department prior to expiration of the thirty-day period, then the person or health care facility must seek Certificate of Need review pursuant to the provisions of the Act.
