The historic core is roughly rectangular in plan and is of concrete block construction. A front-gabled porch sheltering the main entrance has been enclosed to create an entry vestibule. A band of wood frame picture windows is located to the north of the entrance, wrapping around the corner of the building and continuing onto the north side elevation. A large flat-roofed carport is attached to this side elevation. The rear of the building jogs back, creating an uneven roofline. The remainder of the windows on the historic core are aluminum frame horizontal two-over-two double-hung sashes.

Alterations (including date(s), if known):

To the south of the historic core lies a large circa 1970 rectangular addition that is clad in vertical wood siding. A small, unsupported front-gabled porch shelters the modern metal and glass door. Aluminum frame double-hung sash windows. A small, unfenestrated rectangular room has been added to the south elevation of the addition.
