I WAS BORN CLUBFOOTED IN BOTH FEET. I WAS ACCEPTED AT SHRINE'S HOSPITAL IN SOUTH CAROLINA when I WAS A young boy. Surgeons OPERATED ON BOTH OF MY CLUBFEET AND TURNED THEM TO A NORMAL position.

When I WAS OF PROPER AGE THE ARMY ACCEPTED ME. I SERVED 2 YEARS WITH A GOOD RECORD. SPECIAL SHOP WALKING BOOTS WERE ISSUED. AFTER SERVICE DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS DETERMINED MY OVERALL OR COMBINED RATING FOR disability TO BE 10%, SERVICE CONNECTED FOR BILATERAL CLUBFEET WHICH WORSENERED AS THE RESULT OF MILITARY SERVICE. MY CONDITION HAS WORSENERED BUT I STILL RECEIVE 10%. I HAVE APPEALED MORE THAN ONCE.

Quite Recently I WAS APPROVED FOR A

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battery propelled riding chair as walking became more painful. ALSO APPROVED WAS A SPECIAL SHOWER INSTALLED IN THE BATHROOM. These were much needed due to my health. STILL NO INCREASE IN PERCENT OF DISABILITY INCOME.

The purpose of this letter is to ASK if you could REFER me to someone who could give me ADVICE OR ASSISTANCE IN OR BOTH STATE OR FEDERAL GOVERNMENT TO HAVE MORE SUCCESS IN A MUCH HIGHER PERCENT OF DISABILITY INCOME. I feel it should be 100%. I suffer pain on-going, etc.
