Subject: Rep. Rivers Conversation

Katherine,

I spoke with Rep. Rivers today and he was concerned about two scheduling requests he submitted. The first request was for a radio station interview on a show that is hosted by a friend of Rep. Rivers who is very involved in the Republican party. He stated that this request has been outstanding for over a year at this point. I explained to him that it was on the campaign staff's radar and that I would follow up with them on the status of the request. The second request was for a GOP breakfast in Berkeley County scheduled for November. Rep. Rivers received a response that the event was scheduled too far out and to wait closer to the event. He learned recently that Governor Haley will be attending a GOP event with Governor Christie in October, so he wondered why would he be told that his event was too far out to be scheduled. I told him that I believed that particular event was being organized by campaign staff. Rep. Rivers commented that it would be very beneficial for Governor Haley to attend this breakfast because it will be held in between two voting precincts, Goose Creek 1 and Goose Creek 2 that would be beneficial for campaigning purposes.
