ServSafe Food Protection Manager Certification

A Food Protection Manager certification course, sponsored by the Clemson University Extension Service, will be held October 15-16 in Columbia, SC.

SC Livestock Industry Threatened by Drought

Time and water are running out for SC cattlemen. With no relief in sight, the drought puts the state’s livestock industry at significant risk, according to Clemson University experts.

"We are hearing that some farmers are selling off their herds because they don’t have enough water for their stock," said Terry Sudduth of the Clemson animal and veterinary sciences department. "If we don’t get significant rainfalls soon, the industry faces real trouble."

Streams and wells are going dry in several counties. Forced livestock sales are contributing to lower prices that farmers are receiving for their cattle.

"Pastures and hay are concerns, too," said Sudduth. "Most pastures throughout the Southeast are dormant, but many cattlemen and small-animal owners are now feeding hay to sustain their herds. Supplies of hay are expected to be quite limited as we enter the winter months."

The SC Market Bulletin and County Extension Offices are valuable sources of information for assisting livestock producers in locating hay for sale. The SC Department of Agriculture encourages producers looking for hay to check the Market Bulletin. Additional hay and feed web sites can be obtained from <http://www.clemson.edu/extension/drought/hay.htm>.

Commissioner’s Column

Snowing Cotton in the Fall

As you drive by a gin in the next few weeks, you’ll likely think it’s snowing. But, the white stuff you’ll see is actually cotton.

Cotton has always been a vital part of agriculture in South Carolina. The first experiments with cotton were made shortly after the arrival in 1670 of the first permanent settlers. They were ordered to bring cottonseed with them from the Barbadoes. In 1747 seven bags appeared on the list of exports from Charleston.

In 1790 William Elliott began to grow sea island cotton on Hilton Head. Successful cotton production spurred the establishment of a cotton homespun manufacturing company by Scotch-Irish settlers in Williamsburg County. Manufacturing cotton in those days meant that the field laborers not only picked cotton in the fields, but they were also required to pick four pounds of lint from the seed by hand a week in addition to their ordinary work. The manufacturing process changed greatly with the invention of the gin by Eli Whitney in 1792.

The first water-powered gin in South Carolina was built in 1795 on Mill Creek near Monticello in Fairfield by Captain James Kincaid, and a few years later another gin was erected by General Wade Hampton near Columbia. By the 1940s, more than 800 gins dotted the state. With the new invention and successful production, the cotton industry became the leading industry in nearly every county.

My brother-in-law, Henry Rickenbaker, purchased one of those gins after he returned from WW II in 1945 from Representative Alex Harvin’s grandfather. At that time, every cotton-growing community in South Carolina had a gin because of the proximity to the cotton fields. Cotton was transported to the gins mainly by mule and wagon. Today, the Rickenbaker Gin Company is in the hands of Henry’s sons, Burchell and Rick.

Gins covered Clarendon County in 1945. Bloomville, Davis Crossroads, Jordan, Panola, Paxville, Rimini, Silver, Sardinia, and St. Paul each had a gin. Davis Station, Manning, and Turbeville each had two gins and Summerton three for a total of 18 gins in the county. In 1945, those 18 gins processed a total of 15,601 running bales of cotton ginning only 3 bales an hour. Today, there is only one gin in Clarendon County, the Rickenbaker Gin, but that one gin processes 25 bales an hour.

Ginning has come a long way since the 1940s. Since cotton cannot be picked when it’s wet, gins had to stop when it was raining. Now, much of the cotton is compressed tightly into modules. Each module builder which holds 15 bales and looks like a semi-trailer covered with waterproof material works right in the cotton field as a storage unit. A module retriever is then sent to pick up the cotton from the fields as the gin becomes available. The modules now allow the gins to run continuously the whole season.

Cotton in the Mid-40s was South Carolina’s principal cash crop and processing cotton was the state’s main industry. South Carolina’s economic well-being depended on cotton production and manufacturing. In 1944, the yield was 384 pounds per acre. Last year, the yield was 689 pounds per acre. In 1944, cotton was grown on 100,000 South Carolina farms as opposed to less than 1,000 farms today, according to the last agriculture census. So, today, growers produce twice as much cotton per acre on only 1% of the land.

Through the years, the price of cotton has gone up and down due to such factors as weather, insects like the boll weevil, and supply and demand. The average price of cotton in 1919 was 35.7 cents per pound. Long staple cotton reached 70 cents a pound in 1920, and farmers were encouraged "to hold for a dollar a pound, for it was intrinsically worth the price," according to a Department of Agriculture Annual Report of the day. By 1945, cotton prices had dropped to 22 cents a pound. Today, raw cotton sells for approximately 32 cents a pound. The price the farmer receives today for the cotton in a \$32 man’s shirt is a little more than 32 cents.

Because of modern gins like the Rickenbaker Gin in Summerton and the fortitude of cotton growers and others in the industry, each 480-pound bale of cotton ginned equals 249 bed sheets, 2,104 boxer shorts, 3,085 diapers 2,419 men’s briefs, 1,256 pillowcases, 690 terry bath towels, 21,960 women’s handkerchiefs, 409 men’s sport shirts, 6,436 women’s knit briefs, 215 jeans, 4,321 mid-calf socks, 1,217 T-shirts, 765 men’s dress shirts, or 313,600 one-hundred dollar bills.

Think about that when you see cotton growing in a field or a few flakes of cotton floating around a gin like snow in the fall. It takes a lot of people---growers, ginners like the Rickenbakers, warehousemen, wholesalers, retailers, the list is endless---to produce the fabric of our lives--- South Carolina Quality cotton.
