Thank you so much for your time yesterday. It was wonderful to get to meet with you and talk about education reform possibilities for SC.

First, I wanted you to know that the meeting with Sup. Zais and his team went well. They are very interested in a joint education summit sometime this spring to roll out ideas for SC lawmakers to consider for 2013.

They seemed most interested in A-F school grading, 3<sup>rd</sup> grade reading policies, scholarships/vouchers for students with disabilities and the initiatives to get more students taking AP.
