The U.S. Department of Labor, Employment Training Administration, announced on September 19, 2012, a \$14.1 million award to Greenville Technical College for the SC ACCELERATE Partnership project. Greenville Technical College is the lead partner for the project. SC ACCELERATE will focus on advanced manufacturing.
