**I. Palmetto Fellows Appeals**

The Appeals Committee recommended to the Executive Committee that the appeals for Mr. Douglas Brunson, Mr. Trenton Emenker, Ms. Anna Tyson, and Ms. Amanda Gentry be denied. The Appeals Committee recommended that the Palmetto Fellows Scholarship be awarded to Ms. Christy Lanford for Fall, 1998, provided that she meet the Palmetto Fellows Scholarship program requirements for continued eligibility. Ms. Lanford will be transferring to the Pharm.D. program at the Medical University of South Carolina and the regulations state that the scholarship funds are to be awarded for no more than a total of eight semesters of full-time study in undergraduate coursework at any participating institution. The Appeals Committee believes that the first two years of the three years of the Pharm.D. program are equivalent to the junior and senior years of an undergraduate program.

The Executive Committee decided not to consider the appeal of Amanda Gentry, who was offered a Palmetto Fellows Scholarship on May 18, 1998. The appeals of Mr. Douglas Brunson and Ms. Anna Tyson were denied; the appeals of Mr. Trenton Emenker and Christine Lanford were approved.
