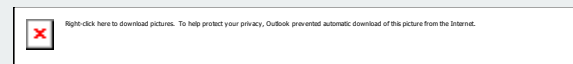
Peter Marx, who became the chief technology officer under Los Angeles Mayor Eric Garcetti in April 2015, has left city government for the private sector.
