Square core with two flanking cross gables, covered by a hip roof with a central chimney. Front porch has a flat roof capped by a wood balustrade and sits between the two projecting cross gables. Off the front porch are three separate entrances, the central door is a half circle frame with six-light window and screen door, the two flanking doors are located on the south and north wings facing into the porch. The porch is supported by Tuscan columns and has stone steps. The windows are three-over-one wood sashes throughout and on the facing wings are half-circle windows with four panes. On the north elevation is a attached porch with a gable roof, stone walls and open arches.
