1. RESOLUTION HONORING NATIONAL WOMEN'S HISTORY MONTH

Councilwoman Cooper-Smith read the Resolution in its entirety. Councilman Wimberly moved to approve the Resolution, seconded by Councilman Ravenell. Motion carried.

2. APPROVAL OF 2014 BUDGET CALENDAR AN ORDINANCE

Councilman Heyward Livingston moved to approve the Budget Ordinance, seconded by Councilman Owens. Motion carried.

3. ORDINANCE - SECOND READING

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF A FEE AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN ORANGEBURG COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA AND QUALITY MODELS SOUTH CAROLINA INC. PROVIDING FOR A PAYMENT OF A FEE IN LIEU OF TAXES, THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL SOURCE REVENUE CREDITS, AND OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO.

Jerrod Anderson stated that Quality Models is planning to invest 2.5 million for buildings, machines and equipment as well as create 26 new jobs over a five year period. The company would like to be located in the County/City Industrial Park. He stated this is second reading and there have been no changes since the first reading.

Councilman Ravenell moved to approve second reading, seconded by Councilman Heyward Livingston. Motion carried.

4. ORDINANCE - SECOND READING

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE FIRST AMENDMENT OF THAT CERTAIN FEE AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN ORANGEBURG COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA AND PROJECT BEARING, RELATING TO, WITHOUT LIMITATION, THE PAYMENT TO ORANGEBURG COUNTY OF A FEE IN LIEU OF TAXES, AND AN EXTENSION OF THE INVESTMENT PERIOD TO ALLOW FOR CONTINUING AND FURTHER INVESTMENT IN THE PROJECT.

Jerrod Anderson stated this was an expansion of the investment period for an existing fee in lieu. The company plans to invest a minimum of ten million in machinery and equipment. Under the present agreement the established company has already met a ten million dollar investment for five years. The current investment period would expire at the end of 2014 and the company would like to extend it for an additional five years. Mr. Anderson stated that the company would like to remain confidential until Third Reading and the Public Hearing will be held at that time.

Councilwoman Cooper-Smith moved to approve the Ordinance, second reading, seconded by Councilman Ravenell. Motion carried.

5. VOTE FOR EXECUTIVE SESSION

Councilman Owens moved for Council to go into Executive Session, seconded by Councilwoman Cooper-Smith. Motion carried.

Councilwoman Cooper-Smith stated that Mr. Brown thanked the Council for their help with Stacey Bridge Road but she commended Sinkler Boone and his department for all their efforts.

Councilman Owens gave a brief summary of the recent Task Force on Crime Brunch. They are planning another meeting for April 24 at the OC Tech Auditorium and the public is encouraged to attend.

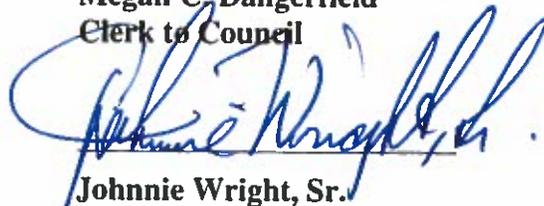
7. VOTE FOR ADJOURNMENT
