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### PAYMENTS FOR RIGHTS OF WAY ON ROADS IN STATE SECONDARY CONSTRUCTION "C" PROGRAM

Payment have been made for right of way on the following road in the "C" Construction Program:

March 28, 1989	Project C-458 - Road S-842 - Marion County - Miriam S. Suber	\$ 4 250 00
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The above is payment for final and complete settlement out of Court of the right of way Condemnation Case. The Department decided it best to pay the award in order that this road could be built.

This report is being made in compliance with Section 9 of the minutes of December 19, 1957.

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AGREEMENT FOR CONSULTANT SERVICES

The Department requests Commission approval to advertise for and select a consulting and engineering firm for the purpose of entering into an agreement to provide engineering services for multilaning U. S. Route 78 from Road S-1304 near Aiken to I-26. The proposed project would encompass approximately 88 miles and passes through Aiken, Barnwell, Bamberg, Orangeburg and Dorchester Counties.

The scope of the work will involve preliminary engineering and the development of final right of way and construction plans.

Funding for this project will be "A Strategic Highway Plan for Improving Mobility and Safety (SHIMS)".

CONTRACT FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES

Pursuant to the Commission's previous action of September 15, 1988, authorizing the Department to seek consultant services for the development of a statewide network level pavement management system, the Department requests approval to enter into a contract with Pavement Management Systems, Inc., for an amount not to exceed \$860,000 for all phases of the contract. Work is proposed to be funded with the Federal HPR/PR funds.

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CONSULTANT - GEOTECHNICAL ENGINEERING SERVICES

The Department requests Commission approval to select and negotiate with a consulting geotechnical engineering firm to provide statewide geotechnical engineering services on an "on-call" basis. It is the Department's intention that the consultant's services will include soil test borings, soil sampling, geophysical testing, various types of in-situ testing and laboratory testing with the scope of services for a particular project to be specified on a project by project basis.

The contract will cover the period beginning on January 1, 1990 and ending December 31, 1992. The Department proposes that these services be performed on an approved unit cost basis with total estimated costs for the three-year period of contract not to exceed \$450,000. These costs will be charged to the individual projects in accordance with the project funding.

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REQUEST TO RENEW THE AGREEMENT FOR THE PROVISION OF SUPPORTIVE SERVICE  
FOR ON-THE-JOB TRAINING PROGRAMS - FEDERAL AID HIGHWAY PROJECTS

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The Commission is requested to allow the Department to enter into a contract for On-The-Job Training Supportive Service with Dennis & Associates to continue providing services for persons enrolled in training programs and contractors administering such programs. Supportive Services provides service delivery for the purpose of increasing the effectiveness of approved On-The-Job Training Programs and particularly their effectiveness in providing meaningful opportunities for minorities and women.

The estimated contract cost and administrative cost to provide these services will not exceed \$57,000. The cost to perform services will be funded with FHWA Supportive Service funds.

REQUEST TO RENEW THE AGREEMENT FOR THE PROVISION OF SUPPORTIVE SERVICE  
FOR DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE PROGRAM

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The Commission is requested to allow the Department to enter into a contract for Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Supportive Service with D. E. Sumpter and Associates to continue providing services to firms certified with the Department as disadvantaged business enterprises. DBE Supportive Services are those services which are designed to locate, assist and provide training and technical assistance for eligible and interested disadvantaged firms.

It is requested that the Commission concur with the award of the 1989-90 DBE Supportive Service contract to D. E. Sumpter and Associates, Inc. cost not to exceed 74,175.00.

The funds will be utilized from state and federal funds.

Agreement for Consultant Services to Perform Inspection of  
Treated Wood Products

The Department requests permission to negotiate an agreement with an independent inspection agency. It is necessary to negotiate a new agreement due to the expiration of the present contract on July 16, 1989.

Funding for this project will be from monies set up for the various construction projects on which the material will be used. Approximate cost is \$15,000.00 per year.
