Hi Christian. Apologies for the slight delay. Just got out of meetings.

1. Theatre capacity is 200. Because we'll have more than 200 in attendance on Wednesday we'll pipe a feed up to a remote classroom where we'll house overflow. We expect 200-250 total.
2. She can enter IT-oLog on the second floor, suite 200. It's the only suite on the second floor. She can arrive street-side on Sumter, enter the first floor and take the elevator to the 2<sup>nd</sup>, be dropped off in the basement parking lot (under the building, entrance on Sumter Street, we can be waiting for you), or enter the 1301 garage (from Gervais Street), drive up to the crosswalk entrance, and walk straight across. We can meet you wherever needed.
3. Regarding numbers, I'll get back to you quickly. My data guy is at a funeral but I'll respond later today/tonight. We always use the BLS as the foundation, but we've had to do some additional research and revising because the numbers change, as do occupation codes, etc.
